dAMBEST carbs set records again, again, again, again, and again!

Our congratulations to Cal Hill and Scott MacKay who have reset their records multiple times over the last several seasons. In the 2006 Sportsman series at Atco Raceway's points race, Scott reset the D/ED record to 7.336 (.664 under index), 179.33 MPH and Calvin Hill reset the I/A record to 8.203 (.657 under index), 164.27 MPH. Cal has been using the dAM midsize billet carbs and Scott, the dAM modified 1050s.

The newest photos show Cal's engine at Bob Kaiser's shop, where Bob has installed a new set of Big Billet Skirted Booster carbs which show big gains in HP and range. The new performance gains should continue to reduce ET and improve MPH.

In a previous News we described our latest investment in the future, our new [Wet Flow Bench](#). Our next project, well under way, is a floatless carburetor to nullify the effects of G-forces. We have received the first of the ECU's for this project which, with a special fuel system, will be added to the wet bench. We continue to be a leader in the carburetor world!

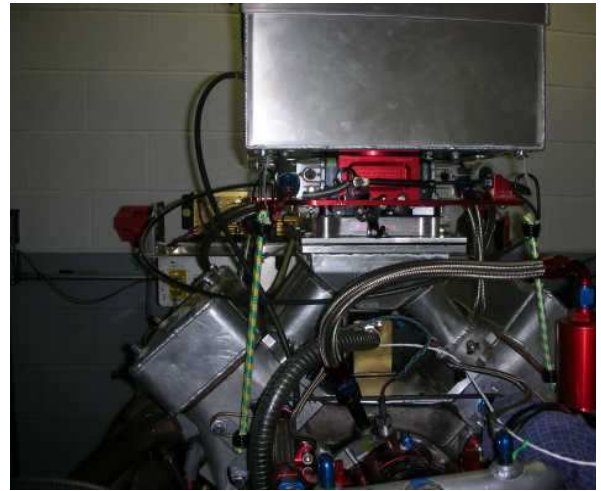
